In order to be considered for selection to **Leadership Moore**, applicants must complete all items listed in this form. Please review carefully for any omissions before submitting. All applications are considered confidential and will be used only for the purpose of the selection process.

The application process is to ensure a class that consists of members from diverse backgrounds, experiences, and geographic locations. Due to size restrictions of each year's class, not all qualified candidates will necessarily be chosen. Individuals not selected are strongly encouraged to reapply for next year's program. A maximum of 20 participants are chosen annually.

Applications are due by Friday, August 17, 2018.

Applicants will be personally notified of the Selection Committee's decision. Acceptance notices will be accompanied with an invoice for tuition. ***Tuition is due and payable by end of October 2018.***

TUITION

Tuition for the program is \$400.00 which covers all program costs, materials and meals.
